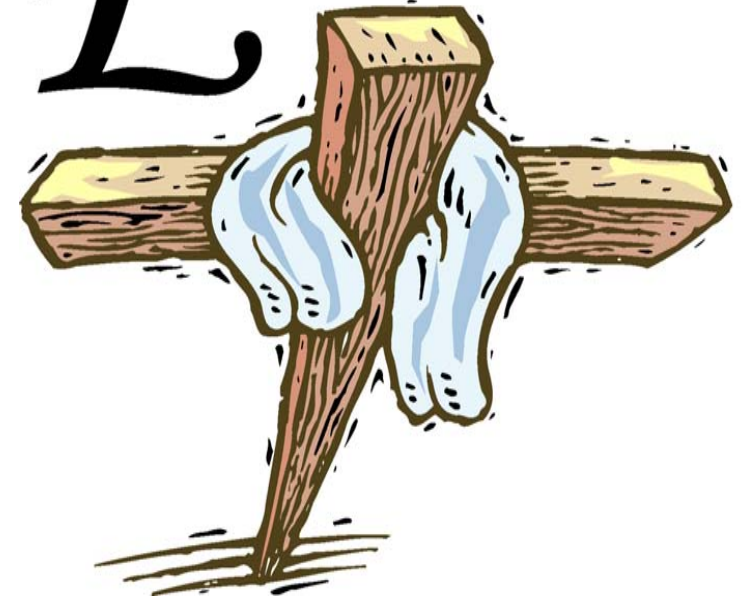

Easter



During the Lenten Season, the Lenten Cross in the lobby has been adorned each Sunday with symbols representing Christ's teaching and suffering.

The Stone is rolled away; Christ has risen and reigns victorious evermore in a heavenly home with the Holy Spirit as represented by a white dove. All of our sins are forgiven and new life is ours; as the butterfly emerges from the chrysalis, and as the peacock sheds its feathers to grow more beautiful ones, and as the Easter lily grows from a dormant bulb into new life. We show the white cloth of purity and perfection and the regal crown of a king.
