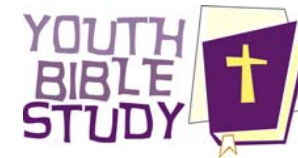

### Bible Studies

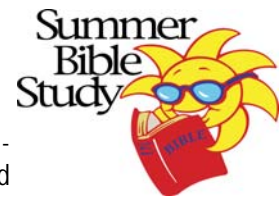
