Bible Studies

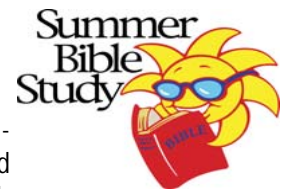


We invite you to join us for the Youth Bible Study that meets each Wednesday from 6:30-7:40 each week. We will begin a new Study on Wednesday, April 21st –
