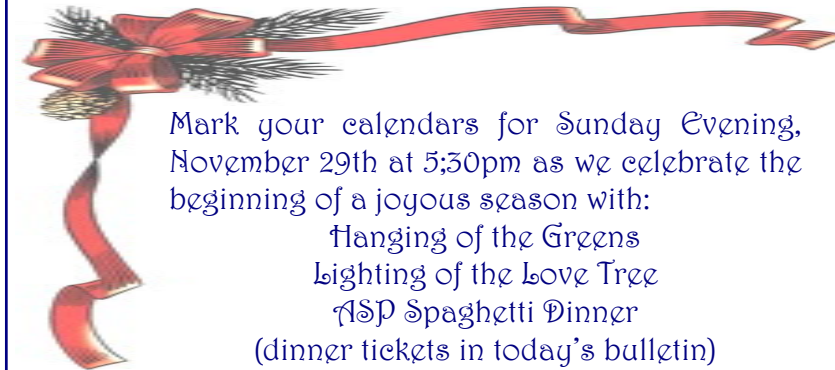
Our Community Thanksgiving Service will be on Tuesday, Nov. 24th at 7:00pm at Ebenezer Pentecostal Holiness Church.

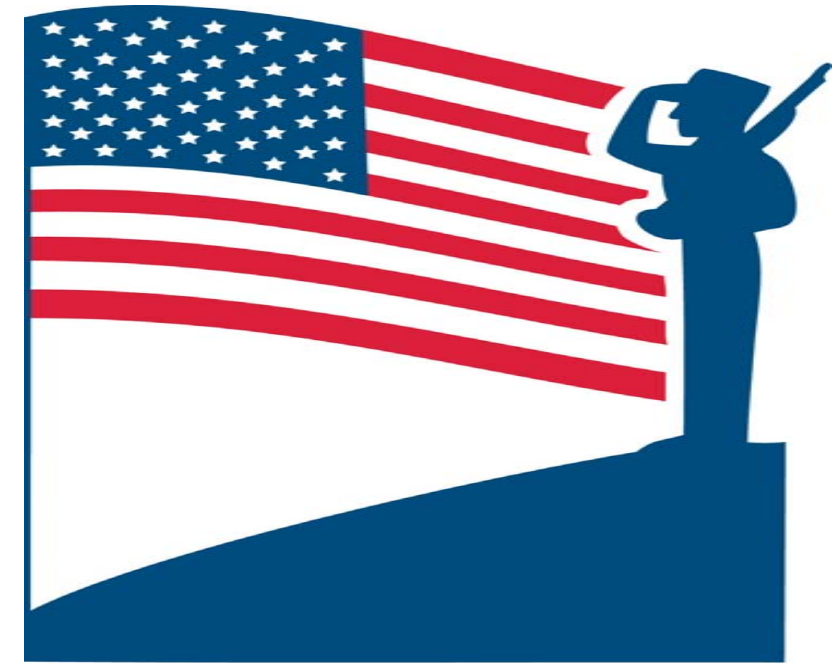
