

Sermon:

“Believe in the Lord Jesus and You, and Your Household will Be Saved.”

Acts 16:25-34

Felt Need:

People feel that their family should be a source of joy.

But their Real Need Is: Their God Given Need Is:

“People need to have **faith** in Jesus **with** their family, **follow** Jesus **with** their family, and **worship** Jesus **with** their family.

Today’s Basic Truth:

“Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you shall be saved, you, and your household.” Acts 16:31

To believe in the Lord Jesus means **first**:
“to believe that He is, Who He claimed to be.”

Second, it means: **“to believe in what He did.”**

That the jailer’s salvation was genuine
is evident **from the four following actions**:

First: He expressed **genuine love**.

Second: Immediately the jailer was **baptized**.

A third thing happens: The saved person shows **hospitality**.

A fourth thing happens: The jailer **greatly rejoiced**.
