- In Verses 11 & 12, how is peace of heart and rest of the soul possible for “the people of God”?
- When do you study “the two-edged sword”?

Thursday - Hebrews 8:1-2

- How is it possible? Who can you get help from, and why, to live this life victoriously?
- How do you keep “the main thing - the main thing”?

Friday - Hebrews 9:11-15

- Where did Jesus take His shed blood and why? (vv 13-14)
- In verse 14, what does Jesus’ shed blood do for you?
