Felt Need:

“**People feel** that they should be Important, Valued, and Respected.”

Real Need:

“**People need** to serve the Lord and to serve the needs of their neighbors.”

Today’s Basic Truth:

“**Love the Lord with all your heart, soul, strength, and mind. And your neighbor as yourself.**” Luke 10:27

There is even a bigger issue than how our actions effect the good in people’s lives. It is described in Luke 10:25-37.

Look at verse 25: “Teacher, what shall I do to inherit eternal life?”
The topic of the entire parable is “Inheriting eternal life.”

The Answer is in verse 27: “You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, soul, strength and mind; and your neighbor as yourself.”

Now, see what the parable teaches us about what it takes to inherit eternal life:

- ◇ Verses 31-33a - “But a certain Samaritan, **who was on a journey**, came to where he was and when he saw him...”
*Are you interruptible?
- ◇ Now, look at the attitude of the heart that is receptive to receive eternal life: Verse 33 - “...**he felt compassion.**”
*Are you moveable?
- ◇ Now, look at this principle necessary for really inheriting eternal life: Verse 34 - “...**and he put him on his own beast...**”
*Are you personally accountable?
