



2022 Kidspace Summer Camp:

We are excited to have your child join us for Kidspace Summer Camp. Thank you for supporting this ministry of our church. We pray your child will enjoy learning and “growing in the Son”.

Registration is **\$50.00** per camper. We will offer 5 days a week at **\$130.00 per week**. Camp tuition is due the Friday before camp week or the Monday morning starting the week of camp.

We ask campers to arrive by 9:00 am each day. Staff will be at the door starting at 4:00 pm for pick up. You will have to call the number placed on the door for other pick up times.

Each camper should **bring their own lunch box and drink**. Two snacks will be provided. One in the morning and one in the afternoon. If your child prefers certain snacks, we encourage you to send snacks as well. Campers need a book bag with sunscreen, towel, swim suit, and a change of clothes daily.

We will have camp counselors that will play and engage with your camper along with fun activities planned each day. We will have a time of Bible Stories and singing of Praise and Worship music.

We are also asking campers with hair below the shoulders to be placed in a pony-tail. This is very helpful to prevent the spread of lice. There are also products available to help deter this issue. If your child is scratching their head, please check them thoroughly before coming to Summer Camp.

Campers may not attend camp with a fever over 99.5, or a runny nose with mucus of color, or vomiting or diarrhea. If your child has had an unusual cough, or shortness of breath, vomiting, diarrhea, a fever over 99.5 or been around someone with Covid-19 symptoms they must stay at home for 5 days or a note from their Doctor clearing them for camp. This also means they must be symptom free for 24 hours without medication.

The children that sign up for Summer Camp must be able to care for themselves in the restroom and change clothes for water games or field trips which may require a bathing suit. The ages for Summer Camp are 5-10 years old and must be able to listen and follow directions. The Director or Assistant Camp Director may need to make decisions due to behavior for field

trip attendance. This is for the safety of all campers. If or when a camper becomes disruptive the camper's parents will be contacted and this could result in *dismissal from the program after three incidents*.
